ACER NEGUNDO FLAMINGO

90/120

(Variegated Box Elder) Young leaves with a broad soft pink margin changing to white and green. 4m.

ACER NEGUNDO KELLY'S GOLD

120/150

(Golden Box Elder) Small deciduous tree. Soft golden yellow foliage, colour lightens in Autumn. 5m.

ACER NEGUNDO VIOLACEUM

120/150

(Bronze Box Elder) Medium sized tree with upright habit. Young shoots of purple or violet. Long pendulous, reddish-pink flower tassels. 5-7m.

**ACER (Japanese Maple)**

ACER BENI OTAKE

120/150

Foliage emerges medium red in Spring, holding its colour well into Summer. Autumn colour is a nice crimson orange. Part of the Linearilobum Group. 2.5m

ACER BLOODGOOD

120/150

Deep red purple foliage holding well through late Summer. Brilliant red Autumn foliage display. Upright tree. 4m

ACER BURGUNDY LACE

120/150

Red leaf Maple. Upright rounded habit. Deeply divided & fringed red Spring foliage turning bronze then scarlet in Autumn. Small tree with wide canopy. 3m.

ACER OSAKAZUKI

120/150

Large leaf of bronze green. Summer foliage turning intense glowing crimson in Autumn. 3m.

ACER RED EMPEROR

90/120

Spring colour is rich crimson, deeper purple red over Summer. Autumn colour is scarlet red. 4m

ACER SCOLOPENDRIFOLIUM

120/150

A deep green linearilobum type with narrow lobes. Bronze new growth green through Summer. Gold and orange Autumn colour. Young plants may show broader lobes especially in Spring. 2.5m

ACER SEIRYU

120/150

Lace Leaf Maple'. An upright growing form with finely dissected green foliage clothing the gracefully arching branches. Autumn colours are soft yellow to gold with orange and red tints. 3 x 2.5m.

A small tree, for Winter effect. Younger branches being a attractive coral-red. Leaves turning a soft yellow in the Autumn. 3 x 2.5m.

**ACER SHAINA****70/90**

Compact bushy habit with foliage of rich reddish-purple, turning scarlet in Autumn. Smallest growing of red-purple group. 1.5m

**ACER SHINDESHOJO****90/120**

Red, green and white flecked maple. A bright foliaged superb shaped specimen. Crimson-scarlet new growth changes to red-green then red-orange in Autumn. 2-3m.

**ACER SKEETER'S BROOM****90/120**

A dense layered tree. Oval serrated leaves end in long-pointed tips. Burgundy or bright red Spring foliage, turning deep burgundy in Summer, finishing bright scarlet in Autumn. 2.5m

**ACER SUMINAGASHI****120/150**

Strong growing upright tree with reddish purple new growth, turning purple in Summer and scarlet in Autumn. Leaves boldly serrated with long pointed lobes. 4m

**ACER FREEMANII****90/120**

Summer leaves, rich medium green, Autumn colour is bright orange. Reddish flowers. Tolerates most soils & can handle dry conditions. Oval shape with ascending branches. 10m.

**ACER PALMATUM (cutting grown)****2yr 2 mtrs**

Japanese maple. A large shrub or small tree. Gives a brilliant red, orange or yellow Autumn colour. Upright tree.

**ACER WEeping VARIETIES****ACER dissectum CRIMSON PRINCESS****90/100**

Spring tones of brick red which get stronger in the Autumn. Spectacular small weeping tree. 1.5 x 2m wide

**ACER dissectum CRIMSON QUEEN****90/100**

Deep red-purple foliage throughout Summer, changing to brilliant red in Autumn. Spectacular small weeping tree. 1m x 1m wide.

Available**ACER dissectum EMERALD LACE90/100

Upright Dissectum type, 'Lace Leaf Maple". Foliage lime-green when it first appears in Spring, darkening by mid Summer, turning bright burgundy-red in Autumn. 1.5 x 2m wide

ACER dissectum INABA SHIDARE90/100

Purple red weeping maple. Deep tone purple leaves retaining colour throughout season. Vigorous and sturdy. 1.5 x 2m wide.

ACER dissectum LIONHEART90/100

Purple spring foliage turning bronze, then green. Strong grower, tending upward & outward rather than weeping. 1.5 x 2m wide.

ACER dissectum ORANGEOLA90/100

Unusual weeping form with interesting reddish bronze new growth and rich green Summer foliage on cascading branches. Not as wide growing as other dissectums. 1m x .8m wide.

ACER dissectum PALMATIFIDIUM90/100

(Weeping eagles claw maple). Brilliant emerald green leaves wider than most weeping forms, turning yellow, gold and crimson in Autumn. 1m x 1m wide.

ACER dissectum STELLA ROSSA90/100

Bright red Spring foliage and in Summer turning darker red and eventually burgundy. Slow growing fine leaf. 1m x 1m wide.

ACER dissectum TAMUKEYAMA90/120

Deep reddish-purple foliage with a growth habit that is vigorous. Weeping maple. 1.5 x 2m wide.

ACER dissectum VIRIDIS90/100

Soft fresh green foliage in Spring, deeper through Summer, becoming golden yellow and orange in Autumn. Strongly cascading branches form a dome-shaped plant at maturity. 1 x 1m wide

ALBIZIA JULIBRISSIN 'ROSEA

Seedling raised trees with spreading graceful habit, fluffy flowers in shades of pink produced in late Summer to early Autumn. 5m 2yr 120/150

ALBIZIA RED SILK

Rich scarlet red with creamy undertones. Good reliable colour, with a good growing habit. 2yr 120/150

ALNUS CORDATA

Medium to large-sized conical shaped tree. Rapidly grows and is noted for its bright green glistening foliage. 10m. 150/200

ALNUS GLUTINOSA IMPERIALIS

Small to medium tree with very finely divided leaves. Tolerates wet conditions. 4.5m 60/80

**BETULA**

BETULA JACQUEMONTII

Medium sized tree, with chalk like papery bark which peels in bands revealing another skin in warm shades of cream or pink buff with horizontal markings. 15m 120/150

**CERCIS**

CERCIS AVONDALE

Dwarf growing selection with masses of cerise pink flowers that clothe the stems to ground level. Glossy heart shaped leaves in Summer. Deciduous. 2m. 70/90

CERCIS FOREST PANSY

Beautiful tree with deep reddish-purple foliage. Flowers pink but not conspicuous. 3m 120/150

CERCIS HEART'S OF GOLD

Golden redbud. Reddish purple leaves early spring changing to stunning bright yellow further in the season. Semi-glossy heart shaped foliage. 5-6m (PVR) 120/150

CERCIS SPRING SNOW

White flowered Chinese Redbud. Rich green heart shaped leaves with masses of white blossom clothing stems in Spring. Compact habit reaching 3m in 10 yrs. 90/120

Limey green foliage, clusters of white flowers along the branches. 3m 120/150

**CORNUS (Dogwood)**

CORNUS cont. ALTERNIFOLIA ARGENTEA 40/60

Hardy. Silver variegated leaves. Develops clusters of white flowers on the upper surface of tiered branches.  
3m

CORNUS CONTRAVERSA 90/120

(Table Dogwood) Horizontal branches in tiers. Leaves alternate, oval, pointed, dark green. Flowers white and profuse. 5-6m.

CORNUS contraversa VARIEGATA 40/60

(Wedding Cake Tree) Displays variegated leaves with a dramatic Summer flower show on a formal, layered, branching framework. Red stems are revealed in Autumn and Winter. 5-7m.

CORNUS contraversa GOLDEN WEDDING 40/60

A sport from a nursery seedling. Has stablized quickly into a layered tree. Margins of golden foliage & cream areas around green. It has been known for not sun burning in NZ conditions. Spring growth has bronze tint, Autumn pink tones. White blooms. **Breeder Vance Hooper (PVR Protected)**

CORNUS k ANDREA HART 50/70

A smaller and densely branched tree than most cornus. Medium pink bracts. This selection is occasionally listed as 'Andy Hart'

CORNUS k BENI FUJI 50/70

Small tree with glossy dark-green foliage. Star-shaped flowers and are one of the best of the dark pink kousa dogwoods.

CORNUS k BONFIRE 50/70

Foliage of deep green, light green, & creamy white. Autumn colour varied through shades of pink, red, & burgundy.

CORNUS k CHEROKEE CHIEF 70/90

Deepest red flowering cornus. New growth is bronze red turning green then bright scarlet in Autumn. 3-4m.

CORNUS k CHEROKEE DAYBREAK 50/70

Green leaves margin creamy white, large snowy white blooms. Autumn tones salmon pink and rosy purple. Compact bushy habit. 3-4m

CORNUS k NATIONAL

Large creamy white star shaped blooms from November through to end of January contrast nicely against dark green early Summer foliage. Red strawberry-like fruit. 4m.

CORNUS k PURPLE GLORY

Deep narrow twisted bracts. Foliage emerges with a purple cast, a hint of which remains through the Summer. 6m

70/90CORNUS k RAINBOW

White spring flowers on brilliant yellow foliage with green base. Autumn rainbow display of pink and deep purple. 2.5m.

Flowers light pink to almost pure red. Foliage carries a hint of red creating an appealing blend of colours over the long flowering period. Autumn foliage in shades of red. 3m.

Very attractive flower bracts creamy white turning cherry red in early Summer. Autumn foliage vivid red. 4m.

**FRAXINUS (Ash)**

FRAXINUS excelsior AUREA (Golden Ash) 150/200

Bright yellow Spring growth turning lime green then golden yellow in Autumn. Black buds on gold stems in Winter. 6m.

FRAXINUS excelsior AUREA PENDULA (weeping) 120/150

Golden yellow branches, black buds in Winter with golden foliage in Spring turning to Summer green and back to yellow again. 5m+.

FRAXINUS RAYWOODII 150/200

(Claret Ash) Large upright ovoid habit, lush green in Summer, turning plum purple in Autumn. Great shade tree. 10m.

**GINKGO**

GINKGO Biloba 120/150

Maidenhair tree. Fan shaped leaves approx 7.5cm long. Matt green turning bright yellow in Autumn. Fruit-a fleshy plum like seed, yellow green ripening to orange brown, the kernel edible. Height 8m in 10 years.

GINKGO B. AUTUMN GOLD 100/120

Maiden hair foliage in soft Summer green becomes brilliant golden yellow in Autumn. 6m in 10 yrs.

GINKGO B. FASTIGATE 70/90

Tight column of upward growing branches with small foliage, giving an attractive almost lacy effect. Rich golden Autumn colour.

GINKGO JADE BUTTERFLIES 40/50

Semi-Dwarf form. Rich bluish green leaves changing to soft yellow in Autumn. Very compact habit. Ideal for the smaller garden. 3m

GINKGO B. LITTLE WEEPER 50/70 L/W

Small maidenhair foliage, soft green in Summer becoming a strong golden yellow in Autumn. Growth arches upward with pendulous outer branches. 3m in 10 yrs.

GINKGO MING PRINCESS 40/50

Another outstanding maidenhair tree but in a very miniature form. Very fine foliage.

GINKGO B. PENDULA

Maiden hair foliage in soft summer green becomes brilliant golden yellow in Autumn. Foliage is standard size with branches spreading outward and downwards.

GINKGO SARATOGA50/70

Erect pyramidal tree when younger, slowly rounding with age and maturity. Graceful weeping appearance. Autumn foliage is a soft yellow. 5m

**GLEDITSIA**GLEDITSIA EMERALD KASCADE120/150

A elegant deciduous tree with steeply descending branches and green pinnate foliage. 5m

GLEDITSIA RUBY LACE120/150

Striking tree with deep bronze - red coloured foliage. 6m

GLEDITSIA SUNBURST120/150

Striking medium sized tree, thornless stems and bright yellow young leaves which contrast very nicely with the older dark green foliage. 6m

**HAMAMELIS**HAMAMELIS ARNOLDS PROMISE50/70

Small growing upright vase-shaped habit. Abundant soft yellow fragrant late Winter flowers. 1.5m

HAMAMELIS DIANE50/70

Vigorous compact habit and claimed to be the best red form yet produced. 3m

HAMAMELIS JELENA50/70

Large coppery-flowers, musky fragrance mid Winter and earliest to bloom. Yellow Autumn leaf. 3m

**LIRIODENDRON (Tulip Tree)**LIRIODENDRON TULIPIFERA120/150

Seedling raised plants with unusual shaped leaves turning rich gold in Autumn. Strong growing to 8m in 10 years.

**LIQUIDAMBAR**LIQUIDAMBAR STYRACIFLUA70/90

American sweet gum. Conical shaped. Autumn colours of yellow, orange, red and purple. 8m

**MAGNOLIA**

MAGNOLIA AMETHYST FLAME

50/70

Early season bright reddish purple. Medium sized blooms on free flowering upright shrub or small tree. Blooms from a young age. Vance Hooper hybrid. 2m.

MAGNOLIA ATHENE

90/120

Large mid season bowl shaped creamy white blooms with wine red base. Rich "wintergreen" perfume. Strong growing upright tree. Felix Jury rated this as his best hybrid. 6m.

MAGNOLIA AURORA

70/90

Large early season campbelli type blooms with rich glowing reddish pink colour. Really stunning. Probably is Blumhardt's best hybrid. Upright to spreading tree. 6m.

MAGNOLIA BILLOWING CLOUD

90/120

Smaller growing hybrid with masses of white flowers. Sweet perfume. Rounded habit to 3.5m in 10 yrs

MAGNOLIA BRIXTON BELLE

90/120

Large 0.30m diameter voluptuous soft pink blooms. Similar to m. Campbelli. A small rounded tree. Perfect for the small garden. Free blooming from a young age, often setting bloom in the nursery. 4 x 3.5m in 10 yrs.

MAGNOLIA CAMEO

Sister seedling to 'Cleopatra' elegant sculpted blooms of rounded form. Outer side of tepals is reddish purple/inner surface white, blushed rose. Trials show 'Cameo' to be one of the heaviest flowering magnolias in the first season. Blooms, wind tolerant & produced abundantly from the first year.

MAGNOLIA CHARLES RAFFILL

90/120

Classic hybrid from England with rich pink cup and saucer blooms. Takes some years to reach blooming age. Rounded tree to 6m

MAGNOLIA CLEOPATRA

90/120

Classic hybrid from England with rich pink cup and saucer blooms. Seems to be a clone of Charles Raffill. Takes some years to reach blooming age. Rounded tree to 6m.

Early season flowering showing a mass of deep velvety blooms changing through shades of rich purple and red developing delicate pink edges. Flowers through to late season. 3.5 x 2m.

Late flowering selection of the species. Pure white flowers on small to medium sized upright tree. 4m.

MAGNOLIA HOLYWELL90/120

Goblet shaped blooms opening to a loose cup and saucer shape. Cream with deep rose shading at base. Upright columnar tree. 4m

MAGNOLIA IOLANTHE90/120

Large bowl shaped rose pink flowers, white inside. Very free flowering sturdy tree. Felix Jury Hybrid. 4m in 10 years.

MAGNOLIA J.C. WILLIAMS90/120

Large early to mid season blooms of rich purple blooms on an upright tree. Trees bloom from an early age. English hybrid from Caerhays. 6m.

MAGNOLIA KOBAN DORI90/120

Rich golden yellow flowers produced freely on small growing compact tree. 3m in 10 years. Probably the best yellow magnolia for the home garden.

MAGNOLIA LANARTH70/90

A real classic. Early season large blooms of rich cyclamen purple blooms on an upright tree. Needs a few years to reach blooming age. This clone from Felix Jury and probably best form available. 6m

MAGNOLIA LENNEI ALBA90/120

Late season white selection. Excellent compact habit with profusion of pure white medium sized goblets. 2.5m.

MAGNOLIA LEONARD MESSEL90/120

Masses of starry purplish pink flowers in early season. Bushy upright bush or small tree. 3m.

MAGNOLIA MARGARET HELEN

A fairly recent NZ hybrid with rich coloured rose pink bowl shaped blooms. The pointed tepals sit in a pleasant cup and saucer form. Flowers from a young age.

Vance Hooper hybrid. 4m

MAGNOLIA NANCY90/120

Excellent mid season selection with wine red goblets and pure white interior. Healthy foliage and compact habit.

Raised in Te Puke and named after Nancy Lawrence.

2.5m.

MAGNOLIA OLD PORT70/90

Mid season upright wine red blooms open to show white red blushed red interior. Flowers pleasantly perfumed & produced abundantly on a compact bush. Excellent plant for the smaller garden. 2m

MAGNOLIA ROYAL PURPLE90/120

Excellent hybrid raised by Peter Cave with rich royal purple flowers produced in abundance. Upright tree with limited spread. 3.5 m in 10yrs

MAGNOLIA SAN JOSE90/120

Large mid season goblets of rich purplish pink borne in profusion. Upright to rounded habit American hybrid to 6m.

MAGNOLIA SIR HAROLD HILLIER90/120

Huge white campbelli selection from England. Probably the best of it's type available. Trees grow to be broadly conical and settle to flower about 3 years from planting. 5m.

MAGNOLIA STAR WARS90/120

Rich campbelli pink flowers with white interiors produced over a long season from an early age. Is Blumhardt's most famous hybrid growing to 6m as a rounded tree in ten years.

MAGNOLIA STRAWBERRY FIELDS90/120

Excellent vibrant red blooms in the shape of a large star. 'Long time flowering'. Upright columnar tree. 5m

MAGNOLIA SUNSATION90/120

Best yellow hybrid from the U.S.A. with flowers of rich lemon-chartreuse and a hint of reddish purple on outer tepals, with inner tepals of dusky pink. Upright growth to 5m in 10 yrs.

MAGNOLIA SUSAN

Compact, bushy variety with long purple flowers, opening to pink. 2.5m

MAGNOLIA TOUCH OF CLASS90/120

Mid to late season upright tree with masses of bloom. The rich wine purple upright goblets reflex the margins of the tepals to reveal a glimpse of the white interior. Flowers from an early age. 4m.

MAGNOLIA ULA70/90

Large rose pink bowl shaped blooms. Late flowering. Hardy tree. 5-6m

**MAGNOLIA stellata varieties**MAGNOLIA stellata DAWN50/70

Masses of warm pink flowers cover the compact bush from an early age. Excellent for the smaller garden. 2m.

MAGNOLIA stellata JANE PLATT50/70

Best of the dwarf stellata types. Rich pink flowers with many tepals on a compact bush. 1.5m in 10 yrs.

MAGNOLIA stellata WATERLILY50/70

Excellent white form of stellata from Japan with many tepals. May open pink in some seasons. Compact bushy habit. 1.5m in 10yrs

MAGNOLIA stellata ROYAL STAR50/70

A strong, upright large shrub that flowers in late winter. The blooms open from soft pink buds and are large, fragrant and snowy-white. Green foliage. 2.5m in 10yrs

MAGNOLIA stellata KING ROSE50/70

Forms a compact rounded, multi-branched twiggy bush. Soft, rose-pink buds open to white flowers which are pale pink near the base. Flowers from an early age. Perfect for the smaller garden 2.5m in 10yrs

**MALUS (Crab Apple) Low/Worked**MALUS ioensis PLENA70/90

(Betchel's Crab) Largest flowered malus selection with large double soft pink blossoms. Orange and red Autumn foliage. Small greenish/yellow fruit. 3m.

MALUS JACK HUMM90/120

Rounded tree with single white flower and red glossy oval fruit. A New Zealand hybrid selected for holding its fruit in Winter. 4-5m

New Zealand raised hybrid, wide spreading tree with wine coloured leaves. Rich scarlet fruit throughout Winter. Hardy. 3m

**MALUS Standards**MALUS ARROW GOLD1.5m std

Golden Crab Apple. Large, clear, light yellow fruit are borne in profusion on horizontal branches creating a spectacular display from Autumn into Winter. Hardy.

MALUS BARBARA ANN1.5m std

Large double red flower, purplish red fruit with bronze red - to bronze green foliage. Rounded tree habit. 4m

MALUS coronaria CHARLOTTAE1.5m std

Large leaves which colour richly in the Autumn. Flowers large, semi-double shell pink. Green fruits. 6m

MALUS GORGEOUS1.5m std

Masses of single white flowers followed by crimson red fruits. Fruit holds well in Winter. Yellow foliage in Autumn. 4m.

MALUS STRATHMORE1.5m std

Narrow upright tree with reddish foliage which retains its colour through Summer. Leaves turn vivid red and scarlet in Autumn. Heavy crops of large deep carmine flowers. Purple/red fruit. 3m

MALUS ECHTERMEYER (Weeper)1.5m std

Graceful, low, wide spreading tree with weeping branches. Flowers rose-crimson followed by reddish-purple fruit. Red new growth turns green in Summer.

1.7m stdMALUS RED JADE (Weeper)1.5m std

Small tree with weeping branches. Young leaves bright green, flowers white and pink. Red fruits the size of cherries. Small tree.

Tiny fragrant lilac flowers. Early spring bunches of yellowish bead like berries. Fine spreading shade tree with dark glossy leaves. 8-10m.

PLATANUS ACERIFOLIA

150/180
